As of July 1st, 2022, a new law requires a Municipal Certificate of Continued Use and Occupancy (MCCUO) for residential home sales in Toms River.

The MCCUO focuses on code issues and/or violations which could threaten a person's safety upon purchasing a home. An application must be made at least thirty (30) business days before the scheduled closing and the inspection submitted typically takes place seven (7) business days after the application is submitted. The application process should be started as early as possible to avoid delays. What is notable here, for our clients, is

After the report is finalized, the home will be issued a MCCUO or denied. If the property fails inspection, the owner will be given a list of violations and a set time period to make repairs, and must pay an additional \$150 fee to have the property reinspected. According to township officials, a growing number of people who recently purchased in Toms River found their homes had serious issues which they were unaware including damage from superstorm Sandy, illegal basement apartments, or boat lifts and pools, where electrical service is not properly




